

From His Fullness Ministries promotes throughout our service to the global church:

- God-centeredness of approach to worship, life, service, and witness. *(What we are and do begins and ends with God.)*
- The prioritization of Scripture over traditionalism, emotionalism, and rationalism. (We attest the old, the new, the lively, and the learned not by the standards of Christian or secular culture, but by Scripture.)
- The normalization of expository preaching as most consistent with the supremacy of God's Word. (We believe the typical diet of regular Sunday pulpit ministry should be neither doctrinaire (catechetical) nor anecdotal (popularist) but a close reflection of the teaching and tenor of Scripture.)
- An esteem for our Reformed theology and history, expressed sympathetic-critically. (We neither idolize our forebears nor do we dismiss them. Rather, we follow the example of the Reformers and Puritans, attesting their teaching by Scripture, and applying to the present what we find to be biblical and therefore true. In short, we seek the ongoing spiritual renewal of Reformed theology rather than simply its repetition.)
- The pursuit of the biblical balance of doctrine and practice. (We seek the reflection of Christ's grace <u>and</u> truth in the gathering [pre-evangelism and evangelism], nurturing [discipleship], and equipping [witness and ministry] of the local church).
- Commitment to cross-cultural ministry. (We believe God has called us to gather in the lost regardless of racial, religious, economic, or sexual history.)
