- Theologically not humanistically. (Against the stream of a self-promotional age, we aim to be God-centered in motivation and ministry.)
- Biblically not pragmatically. (We pursue what is faithful to Scripture, not necessarily what is deemed the way of success by the church or the world.)
- Prayerfully not pridefully. (We own our utter dependence on God for his calling, provisions, guidance, safety, and fruitfulness.)
- Believingly not faintheartedly. (We are intentional about trusting God to supply all the resources needed to do his will, no more and no less.)
- Gratefully not presumptuously. (We praise God and thank his people for each provision, whether small or great, recognizing the privilege of working together for God's glory with the thanksgiving that pleases God.)
- Graciously not carnally. (We undertake the ministry amid our personal sanctification and for the sanctification of those we serve, seeking to emulate Christ who was full of both grace and truth.)
- Spiritually not ethnically. (We work together and with partners on the basis of salvation in Christ, sound theological confession, holiness of life, and relevant giftedness, having no ethnic partiality within our one human race, as is consistent with the reconciliation the new Israel is to model and promote.)
- Ecclesially not solitary.

 (As a Reformed parachurch ministry, From His Fullness Ministries is neither a replacement for the local church nor in rivalry to the local church, but out of respect for the local church and in engagement with her, seeks to support and encourage the local church.)
