A Rallying Cry for United Prayer

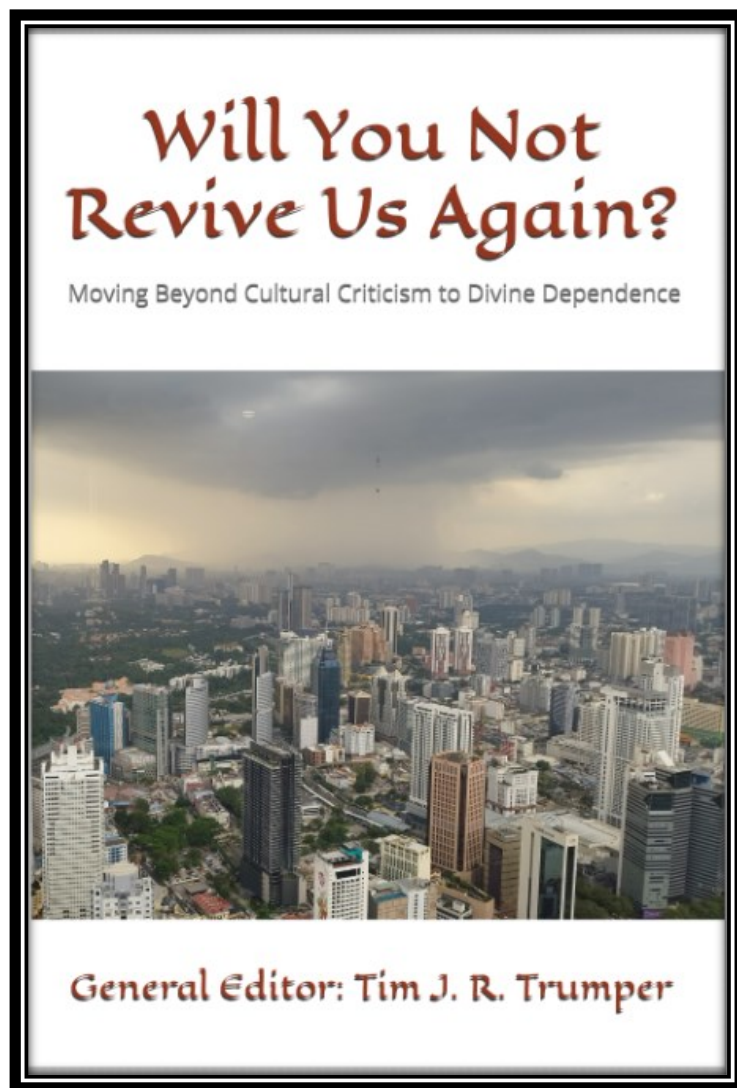
